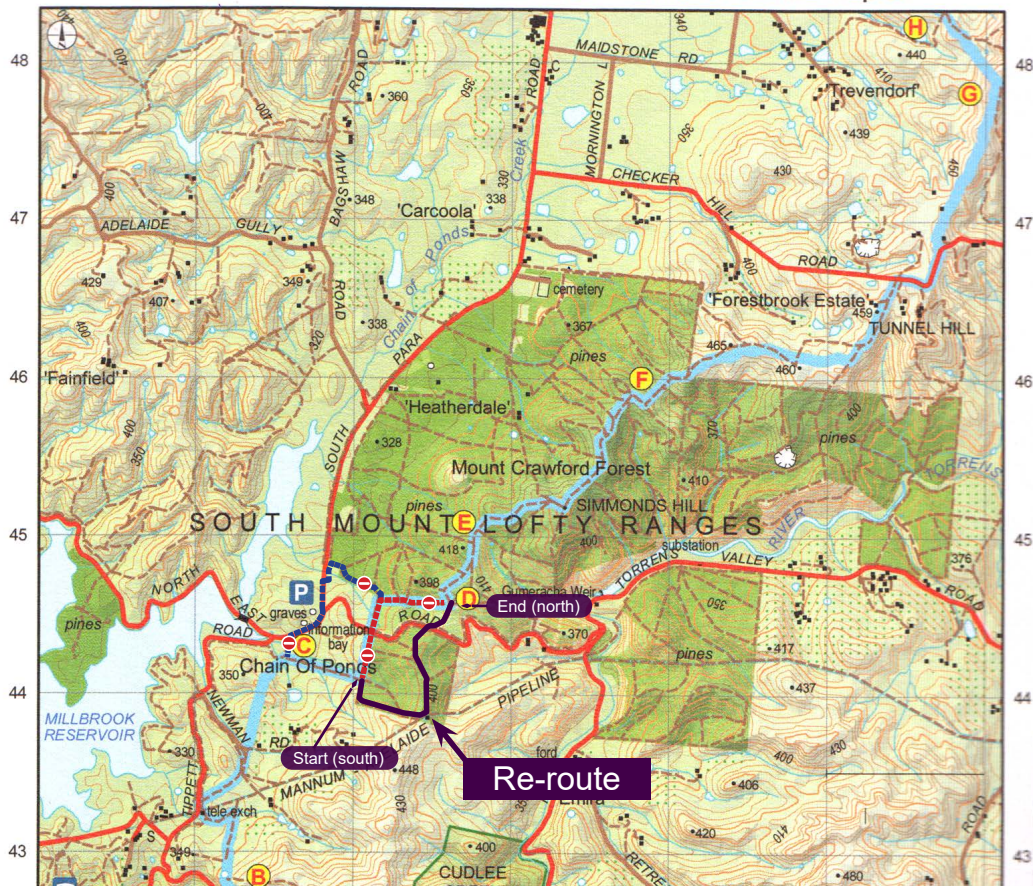

2021 roadworks re-route

From early 2021 until June 2021 the route shown in purple is the Heysen Trail in Chain of Ponds crossing North East Road. This re-route is to allow for a roadwork upgrade of the junction of North East Road and South Para Road.

⚠ CAUTION: The trail now crosses North East Rd about 50 metres from the crest of a hill which makes for a dangerous road crossing. During the road works, there is a 40 km speed limit in place for cars using the road, but *nevertheless please be extra cautious when crossing the road.*

2017 re-route suspended

In 2017 the Heysen Trail was re-routed to avoid a crossing point on North East Road at Chain of Ponds. That 2017 re-route is shown in dark blue, and has been temporarily suspended from early 2021 until June 2021 to allow for a roadwork upgrade of the junction of North East Road and South Para Road.
